programs that benefit students and teachers of Snohomish.

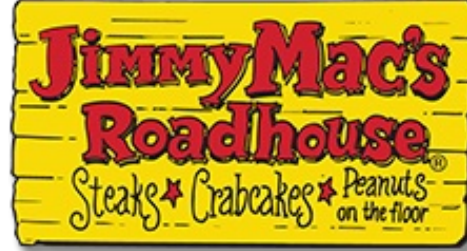
