Milestone Successes in 2014

February - 89 classroom grants worth nearly \$68,000 were awarded to Snohomish School District teachers

March - SEF raised over \$56,000 at our "Imagine...your fingerprints on the future!" Breakfast



June - 176 individual scholarships totaling \$183,000 were awarded to Snohomish school system students from Glacier Peak, Snohomish and Aim High for the class of 2014.


Some classroom grant program examples include: mastering math facts for elementary students, middle school robotics programs and food purchase and preparation skills for high school Life Skills class.



Hansen Shoe Fund - Changing Lives

Donations made to the Hansen Shoe Fund allowed the Foundation to purchase more than 275 pairs of new shoes for our children this year. For many of these students, the shoes they receive through the Hansen Shoe Fund are the only new shoes they will receive during the year. New shoes make a difference in a child's ability to play on the playground, provide warmth and protection from winter elements, but more importantly they provide the child with dignity and self-confidence. Instead of worrying about appearing different or the holes in the soles of their shoes, a child can spend that energy learning. The Snohomish School District provided transportation to volunteers and students who boarded school buses and headed off to shop for new shoes. Every child was fitted with the perfect shoe. Due to the generosity of our community members, local businesses, teachers, school parent teacher organizations, and our students that emptied their piggy banks and pockets, the Hansen Shoe Fund has continued to have a greater impact on the educational success and happiness of our children year after year.
