Scholarship Sponsor Criteria Guidelines

The selection criteria are the standards that inform potential applicants what is used by scholarship selection committees or person(s) when reviewing application and/or selecting recipients. The establishing party may choose any criteria they wish but **will not** limit eligibility in a way that would be considered discriminatory such as by race, color, national origin, religion, gender, sexual orientation or disability.

Common criteria and/or eligibility considerations could include any of the following:

- Academic success
- Leadership roles
- Personal character
- School involvement and participation in extra-curricular activities
- Community service or commitment to a certain cause
- Intended major/field of study/career path
- Life experiences/interests
- Financial need

Once the criteria is set and has been published for a given year, it cannot be changed. Changes may be made to criteria only after the current year award has been given and prior to scholarship criteria being published the following year from July 1 through December 1. Per IRS regulations, the person(s) or committee member(s) that select recipients and/or fund the scholarship cannot be in a position to receive benefit, directly or indirectly for themselves or family members. Selections should be made based on review of all eligible applicants and published scholarship criteria. If a conflict of interest is suspected in the selection process, contact the Snohomish Education Foundation immediately at 360.568.5292. The Snohomish Education Foundation Selection Committee will make selections in cases where a conflict may exist.

Scholarships cannot be given directly to a student and must be made payable directly to the school at which the student has enrolled. Scholarships will not be awarded or announced if they have not been funded by the deadline. Scholarship funding must be submitted to the Snohomish Education Foundation no later than March 1^{st.}

Funds deposited into scholarship accounts will not be refunded. Scholarships with balances under \$250 that become inactive will be deemed abandoned after a period of two years of inactivity. For scholarships with balances of \$250 or more if, after one phone call and one registered letter to the last known contact name and address of the sponsor there is no response, scholarship account will be closed, and balance will be transferred to the Snohomish Education Foundation unrestricted general fund.
